(1) Sand dunes - actively eroding and semi stabilised coastal sand dunes, foredunes


(2) Sand flats and colluvial toe slopes - extensive sand flats ad low angle colluvial

(3) Coastal escarpment [not specifically indicated on figure!] - moderately steep to very steep unstable soft rock hill slopes extensively modified by earthflow and

(4) Extensive soft rock moderately steep to steep hill slopes and entrenched valleys.
